Dear Sophomores and Juniors,

Over twenty years ago, St. Dominic CYO created a Peer Ministry Team to lead discussion and faith-sharing groups, staff retreats, and act as mentors for younger members. The main commitment involves the two annual retreats and approximately four planning meetings for each of those. Peer Ministry is a significant part of the CYO because of the impact it has on the faith life of our members.

I am inviting you to apply to be on the CYO Peer Ministry Team. Because of the importance of the work and the high hopes we have that this will continue as a significant and special part of our youth ministry programs, having the most dedicated and qualified teenagers is of the greatest importance. Please carefully review whether you can meet the expectation outline below:

- 1) completing either sophomore or junior year of high school this May
- 2) actively practice your Catholic faith by attending Mass, taking time for prayer, and trying to live the Church's moral teachings
- 3) actively involved in CYO activities or plan to become active going forward
- 4) committed to the team and its mission <u>regardless</u> of changes in friendships, dating relationships, etc., with those on the team
- 5) open to all CYO members, whether personal friends or not
- 6) committed to the team for one full year from May 2024 April 2025

The team will be selected by a committee that includes myself, two graduating seniors from the current team, and a past Peer Ministry Team member now in college. If you feel you can meet the above criteria, complete the application form and return it with a letter of recommendation (preferably from a school faculty/staff member) to the St. Dominic Church Office, 775 Harrison Ave., NOLA 70124 by May 5, 2024. You may also e-mail scanned/pdf documents to info@stdominiccyo.org. If you are selected for the team, you must:

- 1) Attend a short meeting on Wednesday, May 8, 2024, at 7:00 PM at St. Dominic (this is immediately after the Confirmation meeting for rising juniors)
- 2) attend a <u>mandatory</u> training workshop on Sunday, August 4, 2024 Monday, August 5, 2023, at the William J Kelly Retreat Center in Bay St. Louis, Mississippi. A commitment to CYO leadership must be treated <u>the same</u> as a commitment to a school extra-curricular activity or sport. Last-minute cancellations for the training will result in your removal from the team. You must communicate with family, jobs, etc. NOW to ensure you are available for the mandatory training.
- 3) staff the CYO Winter Retreat on December 27-29, 2024, and the Spring Retreat on March 28-30, 2025, both at Camp Abbey. (Team is expected at both retreats. First night is team-only. Missing one can be discussed. If you cannot work either retreat, do not apply for team.)
